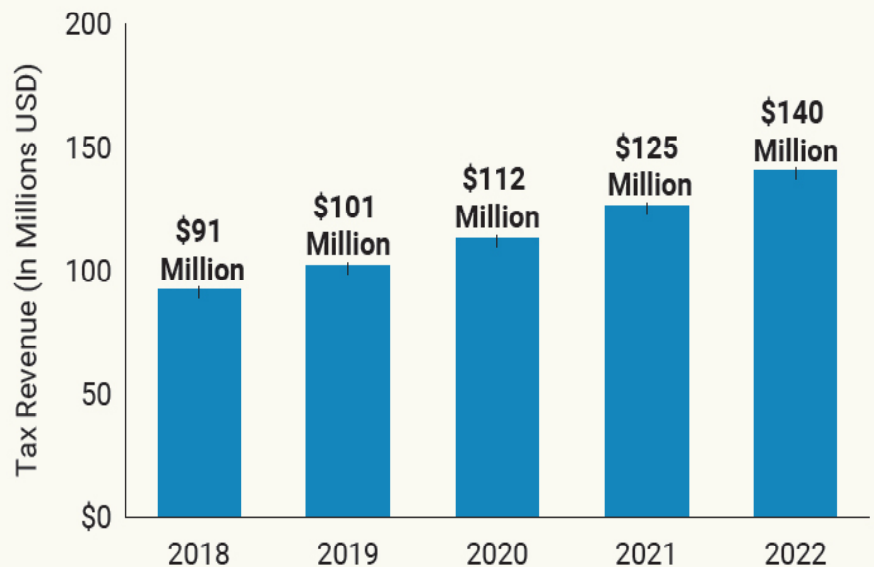
Antiquated policies in Washington, D.C. hurt Hawaii small businesses and communities.
