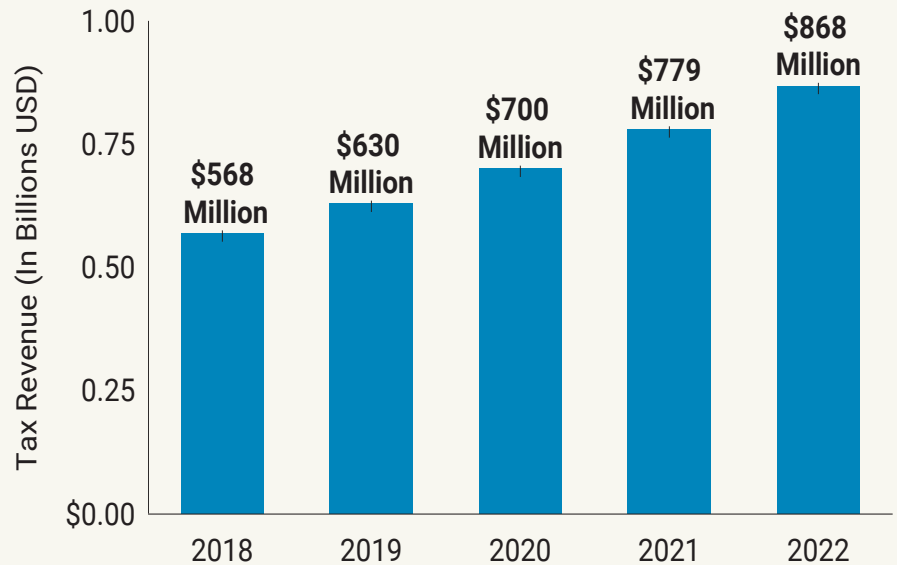
Antiquated policies in Washington, D.C. hurt Maryland small businesses and communities.
